Selectman Chamberlain announced the reason for this special Selectman's meeting was to review the data provided by the New Hampshire Department of Revenue Administration (DRA), relevant to the setting the 2021property tax rate.

Vote: Motion by Selectman Howe seconded by Selectman Chamberlain to apply \$95,000 of unassigned fund balance to the municipal portion of the tax rate resulting in an overall rate of \$22.10. Passed 2-0.

The above action results in an unassigned fund balance of 9.94% which is within both the DRA guidelines and Lyndeborough Policy.
