- All three vaccines will be available for first, second or booster shot.
- The vaccine is free and available to anyone 12 and over.
- If this is your first shot, the van will return in December.
- For the booster, you do need to have been fully vaccinated prior to May 10, 2021, that is 6 months ago.
- Please bring your COVID vaccination card.
- One does not need to live in NH to receive the vaccine.

Registration is not required but requested to help plan.

Minors need to have a guardian named and with them at the van.

You can also register at the library or call **603-654-6790** from 10 to 2 and also Wednesday 5 to 7. Remember, the library is closed Friday and Sunday.

We are working on the logistics of appointments. At this time you may request a time on your registration and we will do our best to accommodate.

For vaccination questions go to vaccines.nh.gov

Vaccines for over 5 may be available by 11/13. As of 10/30 the 5 to 11 has not been confirmed. Go to the library website <u>JATarbellLibrary.org</u> closer to the date to confirm.

The library will be open as usual, 10 to 2.

Lyndeborough residents can use the library, get their library card or get a password.

The Basement Book Store will be open with a "Buy the bag" special.

Masks are needed in the building and will be available.
